Being unfaithful to God by an adulterous relationship with the world.

- → God is pictured as a "husband"; Christians/church are pictured as His "bride" (Is 54:5-7; Jer 3:14, 20, 31:32; Hosea 2:2-5, 3:1, 9:1; Mt 22:2-12; I Cor 11:2-3; Eph 5:31-32; Rev 19:7)
- 2) How do we commit spiritual adultery?
- ◆ *Friendship with the world* (James 4:4)
- ♦ Worshipping other "gods" or "idols" (Ex 20:3-6); trying to serve two masters (e.g., Jesus and money -- Mt 6:24); idolatry is a sin and considered wicked (I Cor 6:9)
- ◆ Loving the world or things in the world (I Jn 2:15-17); having our minds obsessed with earthly things (Phil 3:17-21)
- 3) Why should we avoid spiritual adultery?
- ♦ God is a jealous God; spiritual adultery can invoke His just wrath against us (Hosea 2:2-5; Lk 12:42-43; Ex 34:14; Duet 9:16-19, 32:16,21; Joshua 24:19-20; Judges 2:12).
- ♦ We are commanded to be faithful to God (Joshua 24:14; Ex 20:3-6; Mt 25; Rev 2:10, 13:10)
- ♦ We will "reap what we sow" (Gal 6:7)
- ♦ We will miss out on spiritual blessings here on earth and, more importantly, we will receive less reward in heaven (I Cor 3:11-15; Mt 25; Gal 6:7)

- 4) How do we avoid spiritual adultery?
- ◆ Avoid <u>all false "gods" and "idols"</u> (Ex 20:3-6; Duet 4:15-31, 6:13-15, 9:19, 28:14; Joshua 23:7-8; I Jn 5:20-21); stop trying to serve two Masters -- serve Jesus only! (Mt 6:24)
- ♦ Set our HEARTS and MINDS on things above, not things here on earth (Col 3:1-3; 2 Cor 4:18)
- ◆ Do not be conformed to the mold of the world, but have our minds transformed by God's Word (Rm 12:1-2). Keep from being polluted by the world (Jm 1:27). Don't let anything worldly master you (I Cor 6:12-13).
- ♦ Remember that Satan is a temporary prince of the world, has deceived the world, and the world system is influenced by him (I Jn 5:19; Jn 12:31, 14:30; 2 Cor 4:4)
- ◆ *Do not be unequally yoked with unbelievers* (2 Cor 6: 14-18)
- ♦ *Learn to be in the world, but not of it* (Jn 17:14-18)
- ♦ Be set free by learning and applying truth from God's Word (Jn 8:31-32, 17:17)
- ♦ Remember that we are only temporary visitors here on earth; our real and eternal home is in heaven (I Pet 2:11-12; Phil 3:19-20; Eph 2:6,19)
- ♦ *Keep our focus on Jesus* (Heb 12:2); *remember why we are here on earth*:
 - Witnesses for God (Acts 1:8)
 - Evangelizers\Disciplers (Mt 28:19-20)
 - *Ambassadors**Representatives of God* (2 Cor 5:20)
 - Fellow Workers with God (2 Cor 6:1; I Cor 3:9)

- "Light" & "Salt" (Mt 5:13-16)
- ♦ Develop a closer relationship with God
 - Learn more about Him; spend more time with Him; learn about His great love for you and your special relationship with Him
