Dictionary Definition

"Hospitable treatment, reception or disposition"

"Generous and cordial reception of guests; promising or suggesting generous and cordial welcome; offering a pleasant or sustaining environment; readily receptive"

Philoxenia - "love of strangers"

Philos – "loving" Xenos – "a sranger"

Biblical Principles

- 2) We should show hospitality to strangers (Heb 13:1-2)
- 3) We should show hospitality to poor & needy (Is 58:6-10; Lk 14:12-14)
- 4) We should show hospitality to other believers, and it is good to be in each others homes (Acts 2:42, 46-47, 5:42)
- 5) Elders must be hospitable (I Tim 3:2; Titus 1:8)
