Some Lessons from Miriam's life:

- 1) Women can play important leadership roles; God can speak through women
- 2) Beware of comparisons! Comparison makes you delight in finding fault with others; drives you to seek positive attention to yourself; damages your relationship with others; undermines your usefulness to God
- 3) Just because you are capable doesn't meet you are called
- 4) You should compare yourself to only one person
- 5) You must try to find contentment in the role God has given you
- 6) You can change a bad attitude by cultivating gratitude
- 7) Learn to celebrate other's successes
- 8) Understand that all leaders are not created equal
- 9) Understand that leadership is a privilege and a trust
